

waste management based in Pererenan Village. On January 29th, JICA team and MPH came to su-re.co office to discus about waste management problem in Bali. We changed ideas and insight to solve that problem.

MPH team also facilitated us to visit their waste management site in Pererenan Village. On that 100m x 60m of land, the waste from whole village is processed.



Moreover, this project is still gaining more best practices and lesson learned of composting project. The team visited Temeshi Landfill in Gianyar, Bali on February 24th. They looked for some information about the composting site condition and checked the possibility to put their composting machine there.
